

Hot weather? Help prevent fires

Dry weather means fires can spread very quickly. Please help keep everyone safe.

Barbecues

- Only use barbecues where the park allows.
- Keep BBQs well away from caravans, lodges, park homes, decking, awnings, vehicles, hedges and dry grass.
- Never use a barbecue inside a caravan, lodge, park home, tent or under an awning.
- Never leave a lit barbecue unattended.
- Keep children and pets well away.
- Keep a bucket of water or sand nearby.
- Never use petrol, paraffin or other flammable liquids to light or revive a barbecue.
- Allow barbecues and ashes to cool completely before disposal.

Protect the park

- Never light campfires unless specifically permitted.
- Fully extinguish cigarettes and dispose of them safely.
- Never throw cigarette ends onto the ground or from vehicles.



If you see a fire

- Raise the alarm immediately.
- Inform park management.
- Call 999 if the fire is spreading or anyone is at risk.
- Never put yourself in danger.

Please follow any additional fire safety instructions provided by park management.

Thank you for helping to keep our park, our community and our countryside safe.



During periods of very high fire risk, park management may restrict or temporarily ban barbecues. Please follow all instructions from park staff.
